For Failure to:		Demerit
1	Check General Condition:	
	a.) Green sticker visible and intact on High Pressure Relief	
	b.) Cylinder fully charged > 4100 psi	
	c.) Cylinder connection secure	
2	Inspect facepiece	
3	Push regulator release button to ensure 2nd stage regulator is off	
4	Ensure bypass is closed	
5	Turn on air cylinder	
6	Ensure cylinder gauge & control module analog display are within 200 psi of each other	
7	Connect facepiece to second stage regulator	
8	Close cylinder & note pressure on control module analog display. Allow it to sit for 30 seconds and ensure the pressure doesn't drop more than 100 psi.	
9	Slowly open bypass valve to purge air from system	
10	Ensure low pressure alarm goes off at approx. 1,575 psi & stays on until approx. 200 psi	



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11	Once all air is purged from system, close bypass	
12	Reset second stage regulator	
13	Report to Captain
