Printing Sector-Specific Health and Safety Training Pilot

Complimentary two-day training pilot for mandatory Basic Certification Part 2

Your health and safety association, Workplace Safety North, in conjunction with the Ontario Printing and Imaging Association, is presenting new printing sector-specific health and safety training as part of the provincial mandatory Basic Certification Part 2 for Joint Health and Safety Committees (JHSC) as specified in the *Occupational Health and Safety Act*.

This pilot session will help determine content relevance and flow specific to the printing industry, and key workplace safety personnel are invited to attend and provide their feedback on all training material. Topics to be covered include musculoskeletal disorder prevention, chemical and physical hazards, machine safety, lockout, slips, trips and falls, and mobile lifting equipment.

In addition to helping improve health and safety training for the printing sector, participants will also receive a certificate of recognition following the program, which can be used for the completion of the Basic Certification Training Program, provided the participant has completed JHSC Basic Certification Part 1.
